Workshops will be advertised and promoted by the Earth Center for the Arts.

Workshops take place at the Earth Center for the Arts Workshop Barn for all courses unless noted otherwise.

Workshop times are available seven days a week, morning, afternoon, and evening, 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. from Saturday, May 16, 2009 to Saturday, October 17, 2009.

Workshops and classes should be noted as being for 1) beginning participants, intermediate participants, 3) advanced participation or 4) open studio.

A minimum number of six participants are necessary to run the workshop unless otherwise determined by the Earth Center for the Arts and the Workshop Leader regarding profit expectations or promotional exposure. The maximum number is determined by the Earth Center for the Arts space availability for each particular workshop and the leader's teaching requirements.

Participants can register for courses up to the scheduled workshop date if the maximum occupancy has not been exceeded. Special arrangements may need to be made for tools and materials. The Earth Center for the Arts may provide a store and inventory for tools and materials if necessary.

Visiting Artists Costs:

Workshop Barn Space Rental*:

Open studio type workshops and or visiting artists and resident artists interested in renting the workshop space for self promoted workshops may rent the space for \$100.00 per day, or \$50.00 per half day. All set up and clean up is the responsibility of the workshop presenter in such rentals.

Material and Tools:

The Instructor should determine as to whether tools and materials are supplied by the instructor, the class participants or the Earth Art Center for the Arts. Arrangements should be made prior to the workshop date with enough time for order and delivery.
